



President's Challenge!

The challenge is to take 1 or 2 pieces of fabric pictured, which is cut in 2.5 and 4.5 strips WOF. You must use a full strip of fabric in the quilt. It can be cut into any shape or form that you want just so you use the whole strip. There is no changing of the color. The quilt must be at least 36 in sq. or bigger. It must be finished including the binding. You have until the June meeting to finish. Happy Quilting!

President's Challenge Q & A from the Facebook page:

Q: For the president's challenge quilt can we use more of the focus fabric or just what we were given? **Alma Mellish:** You can use as much as you want.

Q: What is the name of the print?

Lanakila Alexander: I believe that it is called Effervescence and is produced by Kaufman.

Q: The president's challenge quilt needs to be at least 36" square. Can it be rectangular as long as the total perimeter is at least 144"?

Alma Mellish: It can be as big as you want just not smaller than 36 in sq.

Q: So it could be, say, 30x42? Same perimeter?

Alma Mellish: If it is done I will be happy and close to 36 as we are not going to measure anything.
