

### **Block Party**

#### **February Block of the Month**

For this very simple block, you'll need two jelly roll strips (2.5x18" long). We've tried collecting blocks during the pandemic via Facebook, but that hasn't worked out too well. Instead, just save and bring your block(s) to our first meeting back together.


"Fill in the Blank"

This month's block is a two-fabric block, easily made from fabrics in your stash. It's from the August 2016 American Patchwork & Quilting Calendar. The blocks finish at 8" square, and it's a great block for using jelly roll strips. You'll need a solid or tone-on-tone for the background and a print for your feature fabric.

For one block:

Sew two 18x2.5" strips together. Press the seam toward the darker piece and cut into 4.5"-wide segments.

Referring to the diagram, lay out four matching segments in pairs:



Sew together segments in each pair, and then press seams in opposite directions. Join the pairs to make the block. The block should finish at 8" square.

Easy peasy! Have fun, and feel free to make a bunch. We've tried collecting them via Facebook, but we haven't gotten a lot of response. Just hang onto your blocks until we can meet again, please.




