



Fabric 1 Cuts from 11.25" x 8.25" A. 9 @ 4.5" x 2"




Fabric 2 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" B. 2 @ 4.5" x 5.75"




Fabric 3 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" C. 2 @ 4.5" x 2.75" D. 1 @ 4.5" x 5"




Fabric 4 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" E. 2 @ 4.5" x 5.75"



Fabric 5 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" F. 2 @ 4.5" x 2.75" G. 1 @ 4.5" x 5"




Fabric 6 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" H. 2 @ 4.5" x 5.75"




Fabric 7 Cuts from 9.25" x 6" I. 2 @ 4.5" x 2.75" J. 1 @ 4.5" x 5"

Please note, you can decide which fabrics (2 - 7) go in any column in either block - have fun! But please only one fabric (plus the Fabric 1 pieces) in any column.


1. Lay out the fabrics for French Weave A as shown below.




2. Using an accurate $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam, join fabrics in the columns.




3. Finally, sew the columns together to complete the block. Your French Weave A block should measure 12.5" square.
