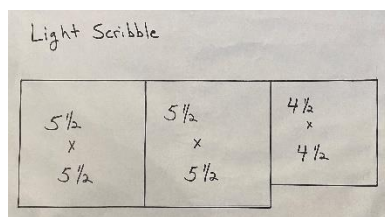


# Ohio Star Block

## Materials Needed:

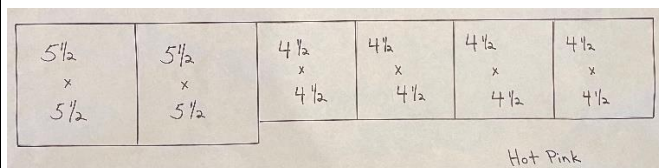
### Fabric 1: Light Scribble

- A. One 4 ½ inch square
- B. Two 5 ½ inch squares



### Fabric 2: Hot Pink

- C. Four 4 ½ inch squares
- D. Two 5 ½ inch squares



Block size: 12 ½ inches unfinished

## Step 1: Make Quarter Square Triangles

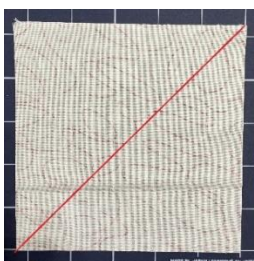
Use a B square and a D square to make quarter square triangles. Mark the B square on the diagonal as shown in photo 1. Layer the B square with the D square, right sides together. Stitch ¼ inch on either side of the diagonal line. See photo 2. Cut on the diagonal line, as shown in photo 3. Press the seams toward the hot pink. You have two half square triangle squares as shown in photo 4.

Mark each of the photo 4 squares on the diagonal as shown in photo 5. Stitch ¼ inch on either side of the diagonal line of each of the squares, as shown in photo 6. Cut on the diagonal line. See photo 7. Open the squares; press each of the seams to one side. See photo 8.

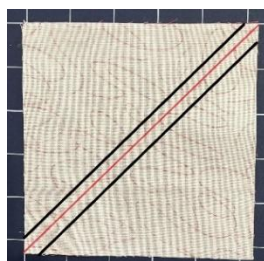
Repeat with the other B and D squares.

Trim each square to 4 ½ inches as needed.

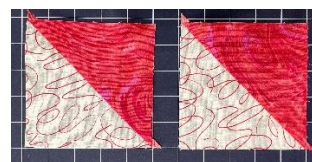

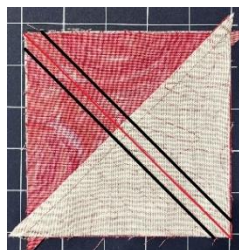

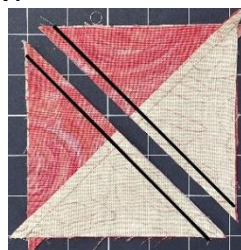

## Ohio Star Block

### Step 2: Finish the Block

Lay out the quarter square triangles and the A and C squares as shown in photo 9. Stitch together the squares by row. Press all the seams toward the solid squares. See photo 10.

Stitch the top and bottom rows to the middle row, nesting the seams. Press each seam to one side.
