

Background fabric cuts from 1 @ 10.5" x 8"

A. 12 @ 2.5" x 2.5"

Red fabric cuts from 1 @ 9" x 3"

B. 1 @ 8.5" x 2.5"

Orange fabric cuts from 1 @ 13" x 5.5"

C. 2@12.5" x 2.5"




Yellow fabric cuts from 1 @ 13" x 5.5"

D. 2@12.5" x 2.5"




Green fabric cuts from 1 @ 9" x 3"

E. 1@8.5" x 2.5"







2. Snowball each C strip by placing an A square at either end, with right sides together, and sewing a diagonal line from corner to corner across each A square.


Trim off the excess 0.25" AWAY from the seams.


Press the seam towards the A fabric.

MAKE SURE your seam angles are EXACTLY as shown.

Make 2 identical units.


3. Repeat the process with the D rectangles, so the you have 2 units in each colorway.





4. Layout all of your units as shown on the left.

5. Join the rows together. Your Japanese Lantern Star block should measure 12.5" square. Press each row open.
