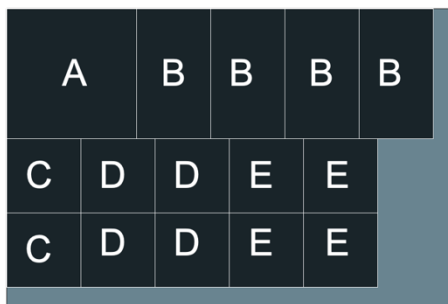


Note: Illustrations are not necessarily to scale. Each kit provides the fabric for 2 @ 6.5" blocks.



Fabric 1 (Dark) cut from 1 @ 12" x 8"

- A. 1 @ 3.5" x 3.5"
- B. 4 @ 2" x 3.5"
- C. 2 @ 2" x 2"
- D. 4 @ 2" x 2"
- E. 4 @ 2" x 2"

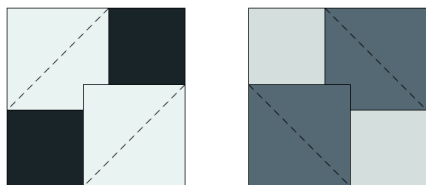


Fabric 2 (Light) cut from 1 @ 12" x 8"

- F. 1 @ 3.5" x 3.5"
- G. 4 @ 2" x 3.5"
- H. 2 @ 2" x 2"
- I. 4 @ 2" x 2"
- J. 4 @ 2" x 2"

We are going to make both blocks at the same time.

1. With right sides together, place H squares aligned with diagonal corners of the A square. Sew a diagonal line from corner to corner across each H square. Repeat the process using the F and C squares.



2. Trim 0.25" AWAY from each seam. Press towards the corners.

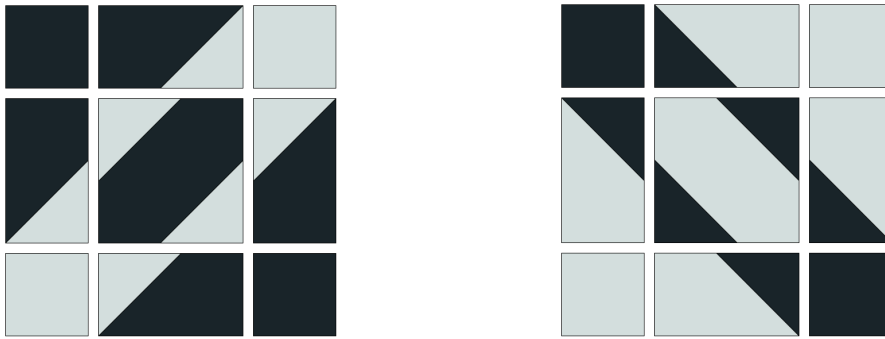


3. Using the same method, and the B rectangles with the J squares make units as shown on the left. Make 2 of each unit and be very careful to make sure that the corner triangles are oriented in the correct way.

Repeat with the G rectangles and E squares (see far right.)



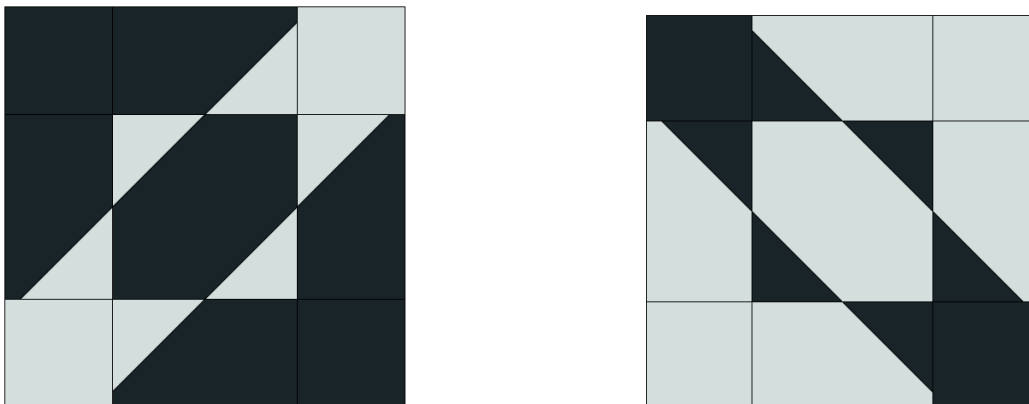
4. Layout the blocks ready for assembly. Make sure to orient each unit EXACTLY as shown.



5. First join the rows of each block. Press these and the remaining seams open.



6. Finally, join the rows together. Your Icelandic Nova blocks should each measure 6.5" square.
