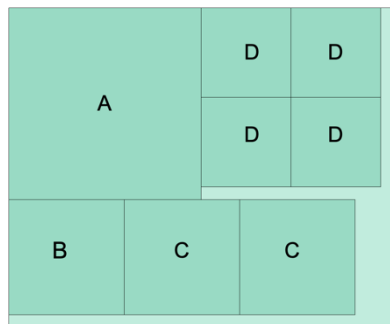
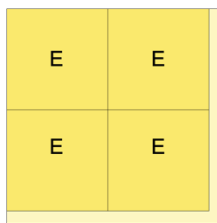


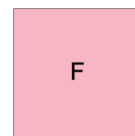
Note: Illustrations are not necessarily to scale. Each kit provides the fabric for 1 @ 12.5" block.

Fabric 2 (Yellow) cut from 1 @ 8.5" x 8.5"



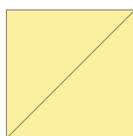
Fabric 3 (Your Choice) cut from 1 @ 4.5" x 4.5"

- A. 1 @ 7.5" x 7.5"
- B. 1 @ 4.5" x 4.5"
- C. 2 @ 4.5" x 4.5"
- D. 4 @ 3.5" x 3.5"

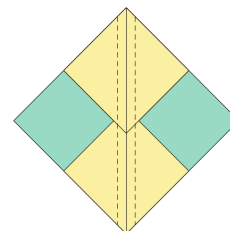
- E. 4 @ 4" x 4"

- F. 1 @ 4.5" x 4.5"

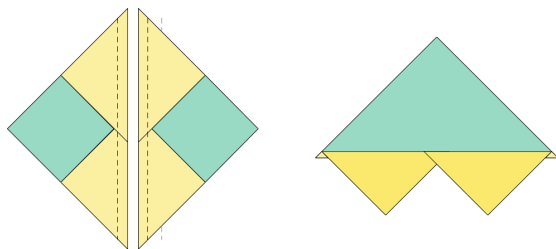
1. Mark the wrong side of each E square with a diagonal corner to corner line.



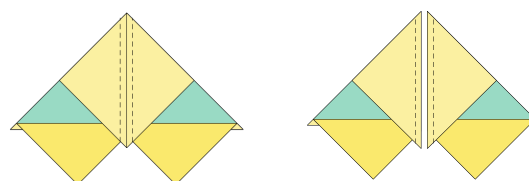
2. With the A square on point, place 2 @ E squares as shown lined up on the diagonal from corner to corner, as shown. Pin both E squares in place, and sew a seam on either side of the marked lines, and 0.25" away from it.



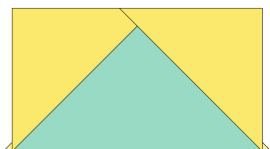
3. Cut the unit in two along the marked lines (see left below.) Gently press the seam in each unit towards the E fabric. Be gentle, because you are dealing with the bias in both fabrics.



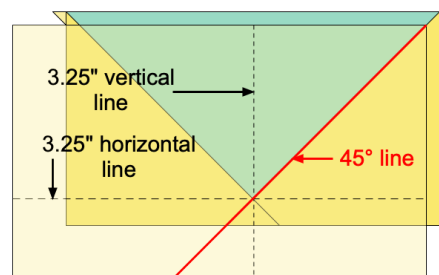
4. Place a remaining marked E square as shown (below left.) Pin in place. Again, sew a seam on either side of the marked line, and 0.25" away from it. Cut apart along the marked line (below right.) Repeat for the other unit from 3.



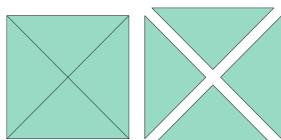
5. Press the remaining seam of each unit towards the E fabric.



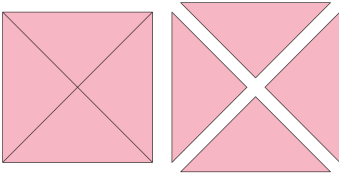
6. To trim, place the 3.25" vertical line where it crosses the 3.25" horizontal line of your ruler at the point where the seams intersect, and the ruler's 45° line along the right-hand seam. Trim off any excess from the right and top of your ruler. Rotate the unit and trim to 6.5" wide x 3.5" high. Trim all four units to 6.5" wide x 3.5" high in the same way.



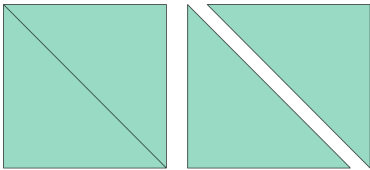
7. Take the B square and cut it on the diagonal twice to yield a total of 4 triangles. Be careful handling these triangles – do not stretch the bias edges.



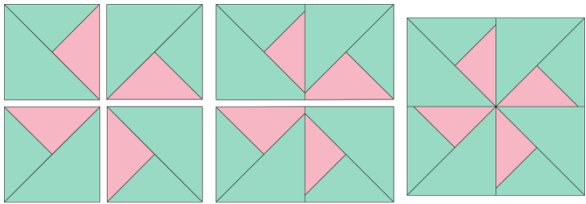
8. Repeat the process with your F square.



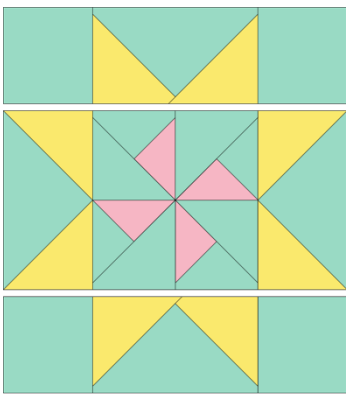
10. Take the C squares and cut each ONCE on the diagonal yielding a total of 4 triangles.



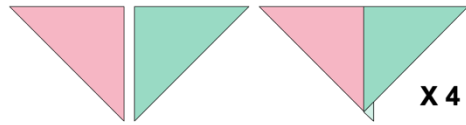
12. Layout the 4 units from 11. as shown below left. Treat them like a 4-patch, sewing the rows together first. Press these and ALL remaining seams OPEN. Then join the top to the bottom. The unit should measure 6.5" square.



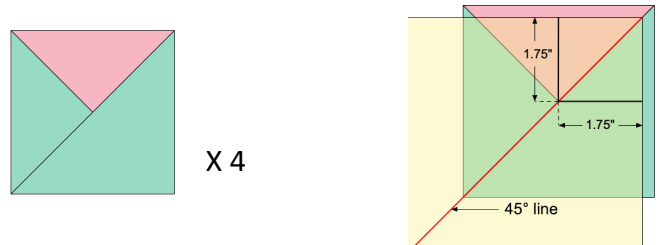
14. Sew the units in each row together, using a 0.25" seam.



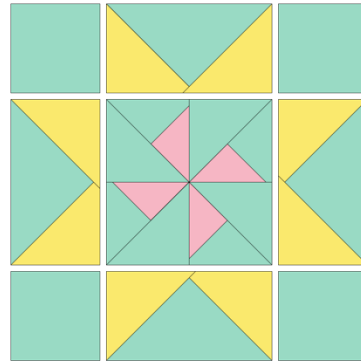
9. Lay out sets of triangles EXACTLY as shown below, with the background triangles always on the right. Sew each set along the short edge as shown. Press towards the background fabric.



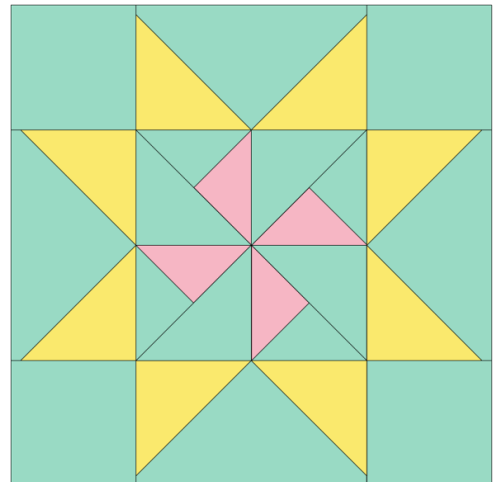
11. Sew a C triangle to the long edge of each of the units from 9. Press towards the C triangle. Trim each unit to 3.5" square, remembering to place the 45° line on the final seam, and the 1.75" point along that line on the center point of the unit. Trim top and right. Rotate the unit, and finish the trim. Repeat for the remaining units.



13. Now lay out all of your units as shown below.



15. Finish the block by sewing the rows together. The block should measure 12.5" square. Please DO NOT square up your block before turning it in.
