

Hawaiian Quilting Supply List

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Paper scissors

Pencil and eraser

Sharpie: fine tip

Newspaper: cut into 22" x 22" squares, 6 - 10 sheets. If you will be making a larger quilt then you will need additional paper in that size. It may be taped together.

Scotch tape

Basic sewing kit: include a lot of straight pins

Thread: Basting

Applique: to match the fabric you have chosen as closely as possible

Fabric: Any size Hawaiian quilt may be created. Decide on the size you wish your finished quilt to be. You will need fabric for that size. For example, if you would like to make a wall quilt, 30" x 30", you would need to bring:

1. Background fabric: 32" x 32" - 100% quilting cotton
2. Applique fabric: 32" x 32" - 100% quilting cotton
3. Backing fabric: 1 yard. This can be the same fabric as the background or applique fabric.
4. Newspaper taped into a 30" x 30" square in addition to the newspaper required above.

Traditionally, Hawaiian quilts are sewed with solid colored fabric. However, many beautiful contemporary Hawaiian quilts are made from batik and hand dyed fabrics. Batik fabrics are a little more difficult to use in creating smooth curved edges. Bring extra fabrics to play with. Be sure to wash and iron fabric prior to class.
