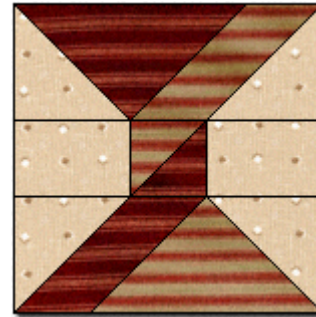


Twisting Spool

This makes an 8" block and is paper pieced!

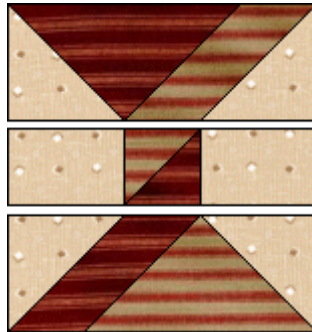

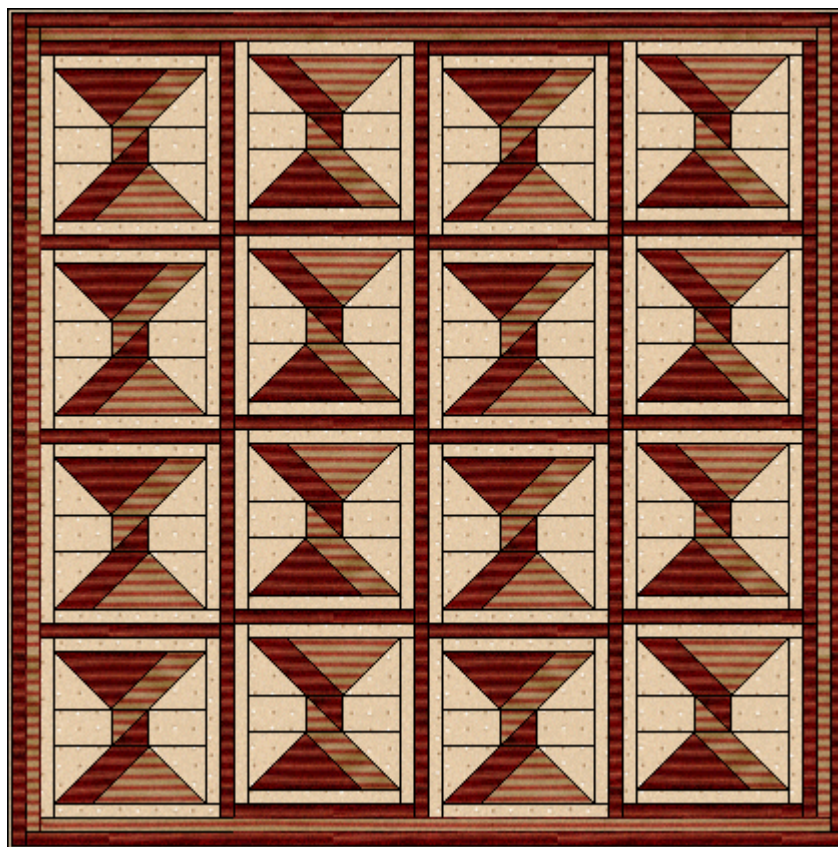
The first thing that I would recommend that you do, is go to the [Practice Paper Piecing Page](#). When you feel comfy with paper piecing, come on back and try a Twisting Spools Block! You will need to print out one copy of each template page per block you want to make on very lightweight paper. Fat Quarters will be fine!



After your three units are paper pieced, sew them together as shown at left. This one is nice and easy! :o)
